- Advertise or promote or guarantee fees charged for the course will be waived if the student fails Exam (promoting "no pass, no pay");
- Advertise or promote they are recommended or endorsed by the Board; or
- Advise, offer or recommend accountants to prepare financial statements or to utilize certain insurance brokers to complete any license application requirements.
