

SIGNIFICANT DISPROPORTIONALITY FLOW CHART

1. Significant Disproportionality determination is based on
 - identification,
 - placement, or
 - disciplinary actions.
2. Significant Disproportionality is triggered solely by a numerical examination of data and analysis on overidentification only.
3. The State defines Significant Disproportionality for children receiving special education and related services and for children identified with disabilities in the six high incidence disability categories.
4. Significant Disproportionality provides for the review (and, if appropriate) revision of the district's policies, practices, & procedures in the identified disproportionate disability area.
5. Significant Disproportionality requires identified LEAs to reserve 15% of Part B funds for Comprehensive Early Intervening Services
