

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, March 3, 2011. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: March 1, March 2, or March 3, 2011. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was February 20, 2011.

### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Earth Solutions, Inc. with a mailing address of 9295 Christiana Fosterville Rd., Christiana, TN 37037. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 02-0134-01/64292) for construction/modification of a Rock Crushing and Sizing Operation located on US Hwy 231, Fosterville, TN. This proposed operation would consist of a portable rock crushing and sizing unit. Wet suppression control is used for control of particulates. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. T. Krinov is the assigned Division person.

For the Bedford County "Shelbyville Times-Gazette"-- published once on or before March 3, 2011

The applicant is K. W. Lankford Excavating with a mailing address of 1055 East Rail Street, Dickson, TN 37055. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for a Portable Limestone Rock Crushing Operation located in the area of 152 Lime Kiln Road. Multiple operations are as follows:

- (1) Rock Crushing Operation (Division identification number: 22-0166-04/64219). This proposed operation would consist of crushed rock, limestone stockpiles, conveyors, portable powered screening equipment and associated equipment used to crush stone. Wet suppression would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source.
- (2) Generators (Division identification number: 22-0166-05/64329). This proposed operation would consist of three (3) portable diesel-fired internal combustion engines and associated equipment used to produce power. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Gibson County Generation, LLC with a mailing address of 4350 Brownsboro Rd, Suite no. 110, Louisville, KY, 40207. They seek to obtain air contaminant permit(s) (Division identification number: 27-0220-00/64146) for construction of a natural gas combined cycle power plant in Gibson County, Tennessee. The project includes the following equipment components: 1- a GE7FA (or equivalent) combustion turbine in combined cycle

configuration with a single Heat Recovery Steam Generator (HRSG), Selective Reduction (SCR), an oxidation catalyst section (to control Carbon Monoxide and Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs)), and an associated steam turbine. 2-a cooling tower. 3- an ammonia storage tank, and 4- a natural gas fired emergency generator. The facility is located on Old Rutherford-Kenton Road, 3.0 miles from Rutherford, TN 38369. The requested operation is for the approval to emit regulated air pollutants. Mr. Jim A. Attar is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Selective Structures, LLC with a mailing address of 811 East Avenue, Athens, TN 37303. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 54-0228-00/64298) for construction of Billboard Sign Manufacturing Operation located at 811 East Avenue, Athens, TN 37303. This existing operation consists of a spray booth and associated equipment used to coat surfaces of billboard structures. Exhaust filters are used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. E. Peeler is the assigned Division person.

For the McMinn County "Daily Post-Athenian" -- published once on or before Thursday, March 3, 2011.

The applicant is Vulcan Construction Materials, L.P. with a mailing address of P.O. Box 7, Knoxville, TN 37901. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 62-0010-01/64321) for modification of a Rock Crushing and Sizing Operation at 1700 Sands Road, Sweetwater, TN 37874. This existing operation consists of crushers, screens, pugmill, bins, and conveyors. Wet suppression is used for pollution control. The requested modification is to increase the permitted throughput production rate at the primary feeder and to incorporate equipment not previously permitted. There would be no physical construction and regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. O. Jacobsen is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Tim Greenwood, dba Southern Core Recycling with a mailing address of 101 Weeks Lane, Cyprus Lane, Tennessee. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 91-0089-01/64285) for a Secondary Aluminum Sweat Furnace operation located at 101 Weeks Lane, Cyprus Lane, TN. This proposed operation would consist of a small propane fired furnace used to recover aluminum ingots from aluminum scrap. An afterburner will be utilized for pollution control of hazardous pollutants. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Thomas Krinov is the assigned Division person.
