

PUBLIC NOTICE

**Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA)** has applied to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division (TAPCD) for [renewal of a major source \(Title V\) operating permit and a Phase II Acid Rain Permit](#) subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-03-09-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (TAPCR). A major source (Title V) operating permit is required by both the Federal Clean Air Act and the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations. The permits are identified as follows:

- (1) Division identification number 73-0013/60775 – Title V Operating Permit.
- (2) Division identification number 73-0013/63256 – Phase II Acid Rain Permit.
