

PUBLIC NOTICE

Tennessee Valley Authority – Gallatin Fossil Plant (GAF) has applied to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division (TAPCD) for issuance of a [major source operating permit](#) subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-03-09-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (also frequently referred to as Title V regulations). A major source (Title V) operating permit is required by both the Federal Clean Air Act and the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations. Also, a Phase II Acid Rain is included for review. The permits are identified as follows:

- (1) Division identification number 83-0025/61209 - Title V Operating Permit
- (2) Division identification number 83-0025/63258 - Acid Rain Permit

The applicant is **Tennessee Valley Authority – Gallatin Fossil Plant (GAF)**, an electrical power generating facility with a site address of **1499 Steam Plant Road, Gallatin, TN 37066-8714**. They seek to obtain a major source operating permit renewal for their Coal Fired Steam Electric Generating Plant. However, it should be noted that this facility has a current major source (Title V) operating permit.
