

NEWSPAPER NOTICE

On February 23, 2009, Refined Metals Corporation (RMC) submitted an application to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) for a Class 3 permit modification of the Corrective Action Permit for the RMC facility located at 257 West Mallory Avenue in Memphis (Permit No. TNHW-110). The facility is located on West Mallory Avenue approximately one-quarter mile east of the Mallory Avenue exit off of Interstate 55 (Exit 9). The EPA Identification number for this facility is TND 067 690 040.

Interested parties should be aware that the facility ceased operations and was demolished in 1998. No authorization to resume manufacturing (including storage of hazardous waste) is being requested in the application and none is being contemplated by RMC. The sole purpose of the permit modification is to incorporate the corrective measures tentatively selected by the DSWM into the current Corrective Action Permit.

A public meeting will be held on March 25, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. in the Riverview Community Center, located at 1891 Kansas Street in Memphis. The purpose of the meeting is to inform the community of the application to modify the permit and to answer any questions the community may have. The public is invited to present written or oral comments at the meeting. A summary of the meeting and comments received will be submitted to DSWM.

A copy of the permit modification application and supporting documents are available for review at the Memphis/Shelby County Public Library Information Center – South Branch located at 1929 South Third Street, Memphis.
