

**General State Operating Permit for
Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs)**

Permit No. SOPC00000

Second Addendum to Rationale


July 1, 2010

The Division of Water Pollution Control (division) is modifying this permit to correct the application deadline for existing sites. The original deadline of July 1, 2010 has been changed to June 1, 2011. Section 2.1.1. (Existing Site) now reads as follows:

Existing operations, including those that were covered under the General NPDES Permit for Class II Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (permit number TNA000000) that meet the definition of a CAFO and that do not discharge and are not designed, constructed, operated or maintained such that a discharge could occur must seek coverage under this permit per the application requirements of subpart 1.6 above. Applications must be submitted not more than one year following the effective date (June 1, 2010) of this permit. For an existing site presently permitted under an individual permit, an application shall be submitted 180 days before the individual permit expires.

In addition, the division corrected the title of the application form to explicitly state that the form provided in Appendix A of the permit was the Notice of Intent (NOI). The form is now called the "Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) State Operating Permit (SOP) Notice of Intent (NOI)."
