NASHVILLE -- The Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development today announced that the U.S. Department of Labor has approved a petition for Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) and the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) for Americ Disc, Inc. This petition covers all workers of the company in Clinton who produced compact disc replications.

Trade Adjustment Assistance and The North American Free Trade Agreement are programs administered in Tennessee for the U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL) by the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development. The programs offer assistance to workers whose jobs have been adversely affected by imports from foreign competitors. The certification by the USDOL applies to layoffs which began on May 15, 2000, and will remain in effect until October 18, 2003, when the petition expires.

Under the provisions of the law, TRA and NAFTA allow for retraining while workers are still receiving regular unemployment insurance benefits. Two separate 26-week periods of trade benefits may be obtained for workers while enrolled in approved training after regular unemployment insurance benefits have been exhausted. Workers who would not benefit from retraining may receive only one 26-week period of trade benefit payments. The programs also provide allowances for attempting to secure new employment in other areas and relocating to the new place of employment. Specific instructions will be provided to affected workers through their local Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development office.

Claims for assistance will be taken on Tuesday, December 11, 2001 from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the Career Center at 599 Oak Ridge Turnpike in Oak Ridge. The Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development has sent notices to former employees informing them when they are scheduled to report.
