Final reading of revised rule with concise list of all licenses currently issued. The rule includes proposed alternative licenses type I and II, Teach Tennessee license, adjunct license, and the JROTC teacher license.
- D. *Alternative Licenses, Interim Licenses, Adjunct Licenses and Permits, Rule*  
Final reading of revised rule describing proposed alternative licenses type I and type II, Teach Tennessee license, and adjunct license.

Final reading of the weighted full time equivalent average daily attendance weights.

Revises rule regarding HIV, HIV-related illnesses and AIDS to reflect fact that students with any of these conditions who may have medical limitations may be eligible for services under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.
- K. *Charter School Appeal - Hattie Bradley Charter School*  
Appeal of the decision by the Shelby County Board of Education to deny the charter school application of the Hattie Bradley Charter School.
- L. *Business Technology Education: Computer Operating Systems and Hardware Course*  
Aligns the title and content of the business technology education course (computer operating systems and hardware) with the trade and industrial education course of the same name.
