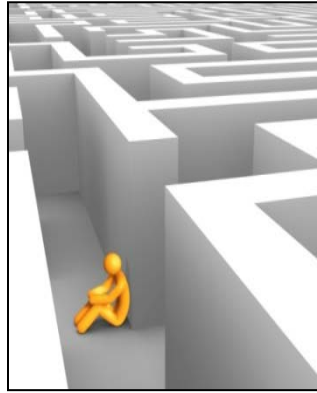


Do you have a child with special needs? Is your child on TennCare?

**Do

behavioral services for your
child?**



Your child's Primary Care Physician (PCP) can guide you through the maze. If your child is under the age of 21, he or she should **Check In** with a PCP for a yearly **Check Up**. If your child has TennCare, these checkups are **FREE**. Your child's checkup will include:

- Health History
- Vision/Hearing Screening
- Developmental and Behavioral Screening (as needed)
- Advice on how to keep your child healthy
- Complete physical
- Immunizations
- Lab test (as needed)

Remember to **Check Back** each year with your child's PCP. A PCP can refer you to a TennCare specialist that your child needs.

Case management services are available for children on TennCare with serious illnesses or special healthcare needs. You or your doctor can call to get case management services through your child's MCO at:
