With the implementation of the new web training contract with Relias Learning Management System (RLMS), we are pleased to offer a large catalog of training for self-enrollment, as well as complete training requirements of DIDD. Many of the courses available on RLMS are recognized as meeting training requirements for CEU's for persons with a license (LPN's, RN's, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, Case Workers, Speech and Language Pathologists, etc). The course catalog can be searched by training topic as well as by the certifying body. We encourage licensed professionals who provide services through DIDD to utilize the self-enrollment process for continuing their educational goals. Licensed clinicians are required to maintain current licensure training requirements, attend the DIDD clinical provider orientation and complete DIDD training requirements.
