Yes, all deliverables created within this RFP must be curriculum agnostic. The intent of this procurement is to help all districts prepare for curriculum implementation; and therefore, the resources should support any Tennessee district with preparation for implementation regardless of the materials they select to adopt.

The Tennessee Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission is statutorily charged with the review of instructional materials and submission of recommendations to the State Board of Education. This process will be launched by the commission, not the Department of Education. The intent of this procurement is to support districts with the district and school structures around materials implementation such as unit and lesson preparation, teacher feedback, and principal and district walk throughs and professional
