Serious Injuries – Child care agencies are required to report any incidents involving a child in its care (including on and off-site activities) where treatment by a medical professional was necessary. It does not include instances where a medical professional examines the child but determines that no injury occurred, or treatment is not necessary.

Substantiated Instances of Child Abuse - There was one**instance of child abuse substantiated by the Department of Children’s Services in child care agencies during the reporting period:

- Physical Abuse (1)

Child Deaths – One (1) fatality occurred in a licensed child care center during the period. An infant positioned on his stomach on the floor was discovered non-responsive.
