**Program Implementation**

TVC's program will utilize a Family Support Specialist (FSS) paired with a therapist to provide home-based services. Agency staff will work with court staff, attending court frequently, to discuss referrals. The FSS is primarily responsible for informal parental support and engagement in services using a wraparound approach. Clinical services (TARGET) will be provided by the therapist. These modalities foster communication and collaboration among law enforcement, court administrators, treatment providers, and the youth and family. A Program Manager will provide clinical oversight and support. Additionally, the Program Manager will implement the Mental Health Training Curriculum for Juvenile Justice (MHTC-JJ) with court staff, training each proposed court annually and re-training new staff annually as needed.
